This term your child will be learning to:

Numeracy & Mathematics

Number

- Half 300, 500, 700 and 900.
- Find number bonds to 100.
- Multiply and divide whole numbers by 10.
- Apply knowledge of doubling and halving to multiply larger numbers (coin cards).
- Develop our knowledge of fact families.
- Add any 2-digit number to a 1-digit number e.g 84 + 7.
- Add a 2-digit number to a 2-digit number e.g 43 + 22.

Outer Maths (e.g. Shape, Measure, Time etc.)

- Tell the time half past, quarter past, quarter to.
- Use am and pm appropriately.
- Use a calendar to plan for events in a school year.

Expressive Arts

Art & Design

• Use a variety of materials and techniques to create art work related to seasonal events.

Music

• Explore a variety of styles of Scottish music linked to the Edinburgh topic.

Dance

 Link a series of movements to create a Scottish dance.

Drama

 Watch a theatre performance and respond appropriately.

Technologies (inc. ICT)

 Create an object which uses an electrical circuit to light it.

Health & Wellbeing

- Assess and manage risk linked to electricity.
- Discuss what to do in an emergency.
- Develop ways to respond appropriately to situations involving bullying.

P.E

- Further develop gymnastic skills.
- Develop rugby skills

Literacy & English

Reading

- Use higher order thinking skills to answer analysing and evaluating questions.
- Explore characterisation and setting through our class novel.
- Use our knowledge of books to persuade our classmates to vote for a class novel.
- Find key words in a passage to answer comprehension questions.
- Use a dictionary to find words by 2nd and 3rd letter.

Writing

- Write a science report.
- Write a letter.
- Design a poster with the relevant information.
- Use joined writing in a wider variety of contexts.

Talking and Listening (ongoing)

- Adopt collaborative group roles.
- Listen to others as they present their novel recommendations.

Science

- Create and draw an electrical circuit.
- Explore insulators and conductors.
- Explore the role of batteries.
- Explore how to use electricity safely.
- Experiment with sound vibrations.
- Further explore the senses.

RME

• Explore the importance of light in different world religions.

Modern languages

French

- Say the numbers to 50.
- Read and say the days of the week and months.
- Speak about our likes and dislikes.
- Say words related to Christmas.
