Maths and Numeracy is taught through a mixture of whole class, group and paired work. An active, investigative approach is encouraged across the range of topics, with cross curricular links being made. Real life contexts are used wherever possible.

Topics covered this year will include:

- Understand 4 digit numbers
- Complete a 6 fact challenge using my times table knowledge
- Find the missing piece to a 1000 using my number bond facts to 10
- Use the column method for division
- Convert time from 24 hour clock to analogue

- Use a variety of strategies to help solve problems

- Find symmetry in shapes
- Identify different types of triangles

Light: explore reflections, the formation of shadows and the mixing of coloured lights.

Literacy & English

Literacy and English is embedded throughout the curriculum. Particular areas of focus will be:

Reading

- Read and respond to group novels using Blooms taxonomy
- Reading for information- skimming and scanning
- Understanding the text features of an atlas and topic books
- Reading high frequency and core topic words with fluency and understanding
- Cloze procedure and multiple choice comprehension

Writing

- Create a newspaper about a Jacobite battle
- Personal and imaginative responses linked to topic
- Developing vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation
- Functional writing- a historical person fact-file made using research notes

Talking and Listening

- Effective communication and active listening in a variety of contexts
- Note making from videos
- Discussion of topical news items

RME

- Beliefs, important figures and stories from other world religions.

- Effective search, manipulating images and familiarisation with Powerpoint.

- French- numbers 0-50, 51-69 and French traditions
