**Term 3 (January - April 2020) Class: P1**  
**This term we will:**

**Maths**

**Number:**

- Recognise, write and order two-digit numbers up to 20 (and beyond for some children).
- Use patterns we know (such as domino, pairs and doubles) to help calculate how many altogether.
- Share collections of objects into equal sized groups.
- Do simple mental addition by holding a number in our head and counting on.
- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's for some children.

**Time:**

- Be able to talk about the date, day, month and season.
- Learn that a clock has a long hand and a short hand which is used to tell what time it is (o'clock.)
- Learn to read o'clock times on analogue and digital clocks.

**Money:**

- Be able to talk about money, and how it is used in the real world e.g. buying, change, saving.
- Learn to recognise coins and notes and make small amounts.

**Literacy**

**Reading:**

- Continue making progress with our reading books, using a selection of strategies to read words we don't know yet.
- Learn the tricky words and our word walls by sight.
- Develop our ability to ask and answer questions about the books we read.

**Writing:**

- Write simple three or four letter words by sounding out.
- Form all letters correctly.
- Continue to expand our own ideas when writing simple sentences.
- Experience writing for different purposes e.g. letters, recording information, instructions.

**Talking and Listening:**

- Give a short talk about a family member's favourite toy.
- Listen to and give feedback to others about their talk.
- Read our own sentences to the class.

**Expressive Arts**

**Art:**

- Be creative during design challenges when building toys and exploring forces.

**Music:**

- Use our voice in different ways when singing songs.
- Use percussion instruments to create sound maps.

**Drama**

- Using movement, expression and voice to become different toys.

**Health and Wellbeing**

**PE:**

- Learn how to hold a balance, travel, jump and land safely using a variety of equipment in gymnastics.
- Improve our flexibility and fitness to help us participate in gymnastics.

**Building Resilience**

- Develop confidence and a growth mindset through learning from our mistakes and supporting each other's learning.

**Science**

**Living Things:**

- Continue to observe the changes that happen with the seasons.
- Visiting our local surroundings to search for signs of spring.

**Forces and Materials:**

- Explore forces through toys and how they move.
- Explore forces in our local environment.
- Explore the different materials toys are made from and why.

**Modern Languages**

**French:**

- Continue to revise and use simple greetings in French.
- Learn the colours in French.

**Social Studies**

- Research toys from the past and compare them to present day.

**RME**

- Use fables and traditional tales to investigate different cultures and religions during story time.

**This term it would be particularly helpful if parents could please:**

- Please ensure homework bags are brought in every day as reading books are needed daily. We need all reading books returned on a Friday as they are used for the next group of children.
- Please provide your child with a P.E kit. Please ensure the kit could be used inside and out e.g. long trousers and trainers.
