This term your child will be learning to:

English and Literacy

Reading:

- Continue making progress with fluency in reading fiction and non-fiction books.
- Begin to answer more analysing questions linked to a
- Select texts and reading for enjoyment in our school library and in the classroom.

Writing:

- Develop and use the VCOP techniques when creating texts (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation).
- Develop an awareness of paragraphs within writing.
- Create various texts in different genres (imaginative stories and diary entries) linked to our Viking topic.
- Recognise and apply their knowledge of the spelling rules to read and spell new words.

Handwriting:

Begin joined handwriting.

Talking and Listening:

- Deliver a presentation to the class linked to our Vikings topic.
- Further develop our Talk Partner talking and listening

Expressive Arts

Art and Design:

- Create a Viking outfit and armour.
- Use clay to design and create a Viking artefact.

Music:

Contribute to a performance for the whole-school show.

Drama:

- Develop skills when performing to an audience.
- Work as part of a "squad" to create a routine to perform at "Vikings got talent – Up Helly Aa" festival.

Modern Languages

- Talk about days of the week, months of the year and seasons.
- Follow simple classroom instructions.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Number & Number Processes:

- Explore numbers to 1000 (and beyond for some), including backwards number sequences.
- Develop an understanding of addition and subtraction to and beyond 100. Also adding and subtracting across a decade.
- Develop their understanding of multiplication and division within the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table, using real-life contexts.
- Explore fractions and make links to division.

Numerals:

Compare Viking numerals to present day numbers.

Problem Solving:

Begin to apply their maths knowledge and skills to solve word problems.

Social Studies and Science

Vikings:

- Label a map to show a Viking's journey to Scotland.
- Compare similarities and differences of a Viking's life to
- Research information about Viking life.
- Explore important traditions and festivals "Up Helly Aa"

Technologies

- Use ICT to enhance learning using search engines to research areas of our Viking topic.
- Design and build our own Viking artefact.

Health & Wellbeing
