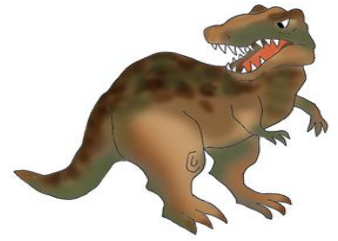

This term your child will be learning to:

Maths and Numeracy

Number & Number Processes

- Exploring numbers up to 100 (and beyond for some), including backwards number sequences.
- Developing an understanding of addition and subtraction up to 30. Also adding and subtracting over a decade.
- Developing our understanding of sharing equally in groups (basis for understanding multiplication and division).

Shape

- Recognising the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Measurement

- Developing an understanding of distance and comparing distances.
- Identifying the correct measurement unit to use.

Technologies

- Using technologies (such as computers, iPads, tablets etc) to support home learning.

Expressive Arts

Music

- I can use my voice to make music.
- I can create my own body percussion sequence.

Art

- Recreate the work of a famous artist.
- I can use household materials to create a dinosaur scene (junk model).

Health and Wellbeing

- Building Resilience Programme – Understanding how to cope with difficult situations and deal with emotions.
- P.E – Joe Wicks and Cosmic Yoga sessions and Mrs Griffin's PE ideas.
- Smoothie making and healthy recipes.

English and Literacy

Reading

- Continue to experience new texts, building up a range of strategies for tackling unfamiliar vocabulary.
- Developing thinking skills by asking and answering higher order questions about novels and stories.
- Selecting texts and reading for enjoyment through home learning links.

Writing

- Recognising and building compound words (Block 6)
- Recognise and building words with end blends (Block 3)
- Building CVC words (block 1)
- Spelling common words and sounding out unfamiliar words, when writing in sentences.
- BIG Writing – develop our use of VCOP (Vocab, Connectives, Openers, Punctuation).

Talking and Listening

- Sharing our learning with family members in the home.

Science

Plants

- Identify and explain the basic structure of a plant.
- Explore different habitats that plants grow in and what they need to stay healthy.

Social Studies/Literacy Dinosaur Theme

- I will use research skills to find out about dinosaurs and their lifestyles – carnivore, herbivore and omnivore.
- I will look at the features of the dinosaur, using different resources
- I can create a fact-file and research a chosen dinosaur

- Colours
- Days of the week
- Months of the year
- Body parts
