They also tackled the Wildlife Garden; fixing broken items, planting new herbs and making it safe for all our kids.

The Parent Council also funded the new Astroturf strip (lovingly laid by Quintin the janitor), supplied the timber for the decking to be fixed and purchased the new planter boxes for the Buttercup Farmers Pupil Voice Group.
